FRANK

The secret of my success? Well, if I told you it wouldn't be a secret, would it?

He laughs loudly.

FRANK

Ehm... teamwork. And understanding. I believe in positive reinforcement.

CUT TO:

INT. OFFICE - DOCUMENTARY FOOTAGE - DAY

Frank sitting at his desk, Tom in front of him.

FRANK

You're an incompetent!!! An ape could do your job! Here, do you want a banana? You don't deserve one!

CUT TO:

TOM'S INTERVIEW

TOM

He's an asshole.

CUT TO:

FRANK'S INTERVIEW

FRANK

I think I'm very good at building trust with my employees.

CUT TO:

OFFICE - DAY

Frank is leaning over Laura's desk.

FRANK

So, Laura, what are you doing tonight after work? Wanna go for a drink? Or two maybe?

CUT TO:

LAURA'S INTERVIEW

LAURA

He's very creepy.

CUT TO:

FOOTAGE

Laura walks past, Frank stares at her bottom, then turns into camera and grins.

CUT TO:

FRANK'S INTERVIEW

FRANK

That sexual harassment complaint was just a misunderstanding. I have a big character is all, but Laura and I had a chat, and it's absolutely fine now. She knows that I meant no harm.

CUT TO:

LAURA'S INTERVIEW

LAURA

I handed in my notice twice, but he keeps pretending he hasn't received it.

CUT TO:

FRANK'S INTERVIEW

FRANK

I try very hard to connect with my employees, to really understand them and speak their language.

CUT TO:

FOOTAGE

Frank approaches Tom's desk, then suddenly breaks into an impromptu rendition of YMCA.

Tom stares at him, horrified.

3.

CUT TO:

TOM'S INTERVIEW

TOM

I'm not gay, but I'd find him  
offensive even if I were.

CUT TO:

FRANK'S INTERVIEW

FRANK

So yeah, overall I think I'm a good  
leader.

He smiles to the camera, almost freezing.

No one says cut.

FRANK

Are we... are we done? Okay great,  
I need a piss.

He gets up and leaves.

END.
